


Future Tenses

Future timestamps



Form	Function	Example
present simple	scheduled events	 The train <u>leaves / arrives</u> at 5pm. My new shop <u>opens</u> on the 5th.
present continuous be + verb + ing	arranged events	I <u>am meeting</u> my solicitor to finalise my divorce.
will + infinitive	intentionprediction –	I will open a record shop this year / in my life / one day.
	something we think is true about the future	 Boris Johnson will not <u>be</u> a good prime minister. Everton will <u>win</u> on Saturday.
	• offers	 I'll do that. I'll cook dinner. I'll put the kids to bed. I'll help you fix your bike. I'm going to help you fix your bike.

be + going to + infinitive	• plan	I am going to open a record shop. Poris Johnson is going to resign this.
	 prediction – near future, using evidence we can detect now 	 Boris Johnson is going to resign this week. I am going to sneeze! It is going to rain again, Susan.
future continuous will+be+verb+ing	long/ongoing actions at a specific time in the future	Paul will be eating at 10:50. This time next week Paul will be teaching. This time next year Paul will be running a great school.
future perfect	to show an action occurs before another action in the	By this time next week, I will have completed the boat.
will + have + pp - remember 'by'	future	By this time next year, Aneel will have moved to the UK.
		Any time between now and January 2023 Jan 2022 Jan 2023 By: this time next year / January 2023 / next January - I will have passed OET and emigrated.
