  Observations T: 37°C, P: 88, BP: 145/95 (notified Dr), R: 16
  Pathology FBE, U&Es, LFTs (will receive results pre-procedure)

  - · Wt: 80kg, Ht: 190cm
  - Immediate cessation of smoking and reduction of alcohol intake advised
  - Previous anaesthetics no issues → Explained will be heavily sedated, not
  - NKA. Sensitive to codeine. Alert sticker attached to paperwork  $\rightarrow$  Advised to notify all staff, but unlikely to need that amount of analgesic
  - Explained procedure pre & post expectations to patient
  - · Pt signed endoscopy (colonoscopy) consent form
  - Booklet given procedure, risks, pain, bleeding, etc.
  - Pre-procedure: Day before light breakfast then clear fluids only Bowel prep instructions - fast midnight before procedure
  - Admission booklet explained  $\Rightarrow$  Pt arranged hospital pickup
  - · Discussed importance of healthy diet & exercise

- · R/V progress, further counselling, other options if necessary. Results of colonoscopy will determine course of action.


