**Irritating / irritated** – adj. The TV is irritating (the cause) / She is irritating (the cause) / She is irritated (the woman feels that)

Irritatingly – adverb

Irritant – noun (a substance that causes irritation of skin)

Respond – verb

Response – noun

Responsive – adj.

Aforementioned – adjective meaning (above said)

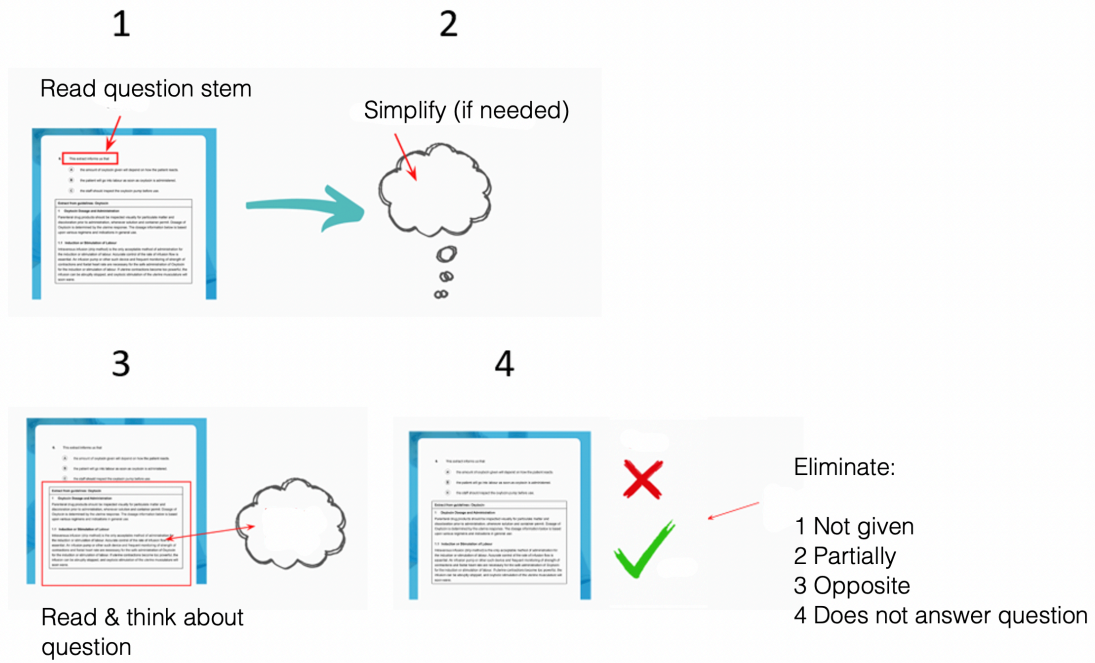
