#### 1. What is a clause?

Definition: a subject and a verb

Example: I eat S v

Main exception: Having eaten my dinner, I)don't need to eat again. There is no Subject... because it is here

## The point:

 $\underline{I}$  went to the house by the river with my friends. = 1 clause only  $\overline{S}$ 

<u>The happy man with the nice wife and children</u> bought an apple =  $\frac{1 \text{ clause}}{5}$

#### Type?

COMPOUND: Mr Green feels down, yet he sometimes has suicidal thoughts

COMPOUND

On 19<sup>th</sup> May, Mr Jones visited our clinic, and he stated that he had been experiencing strange pains in his fingertips.

### COMPPOUND

Linking phrase

<u>On examination</u>, she was found with chest pain associated with mild dyspnea, and she was prescribed medication

COMPOUND:

His examination was unremarkable, and omeprazole was prescribed.

#### COMPOUND

He has implemented some of the lifestyle changes-however, he has not completed them

Exception to rule

I am writing regarding Mr Robert England, who was admitted to our hospital recently for open stent graft surgery following abdominal aortic aneurysm\*



<u>She stopped</u> smoking one year ago, however, <u>she has</u> increased alcohol consumption, <u>and she has a sedentary</u> <u>lifestyle.</u>

How many clauses in the sentence? 2

COMPOUND

He presented to us complaining about his ongoing bowel issues on 1st August 2018, and a bowel cancer screen test was performed.

COMPOUND

<u>she takes</u> losartan, 50 mg, orally, every night, atorvastatin, 40 mg, aspirin, 100 mg, and as a result <u>she takes</u> omeprazole 20 mg for dyspepsia, and <u>all of the above are taken</u> once a day, orally.

Linking phrase

<u>I watch</u> too much TV. As a result, my <u>eyes hurt</u> <u>I watch</u> too much TV. As a result of that, my <u>eyes hurt</u>

Linking phrase

Apart from that, I will eat.

SIMPLE: Mr England underwent open stent graft surgery successfully.

COMPLEX:

as a result of effective care post-operatively[dependent clause], he is recovering well, and he made good progress
