Inexorably	adverb	Impossibly	We move inexorably towards a recession
Influx	noun	Large group comes in	The influx of refugees requires more funding
Overhaul	verb	Redesign / complete change	We need to overhaul this terrible system
Utilised	verb	Use	People are not utilising the support we have available
Up-skill	verb	To train people	We need to up skill our staff
Innovative	adjective	New ideas / creative	This is a very innovative approach
Integrated	verb / adj.	To put together and when they are together they function well	He is not well integrated in the UK Different laws / customs etc.
Undo	verb	Reverse / go back / cancel	We need to undo the damage
Prevalence	noun	Frequency / how many exist / direct: existence	What is the prevalence of Covid 19 in the UK now?
As a means of	phrase	Use for	I use IELTS reading exams as a means of improving my OET reading.
Precautionary	Adj./adverb	Action taken for safety	As a precautionary measure, I wear a mask
Flagged up	Phrasal verb	Highlighted / To make a sign about why it is important NB. A 'red flag'	I flagged up the messy ward as a potentially dangerous
A far cry from	Idiom	Very far / different from	This is a far cry from what I'm used to
Contamination	noun	It is infected or unclean somehow / not pure	The contamination rate is quite high

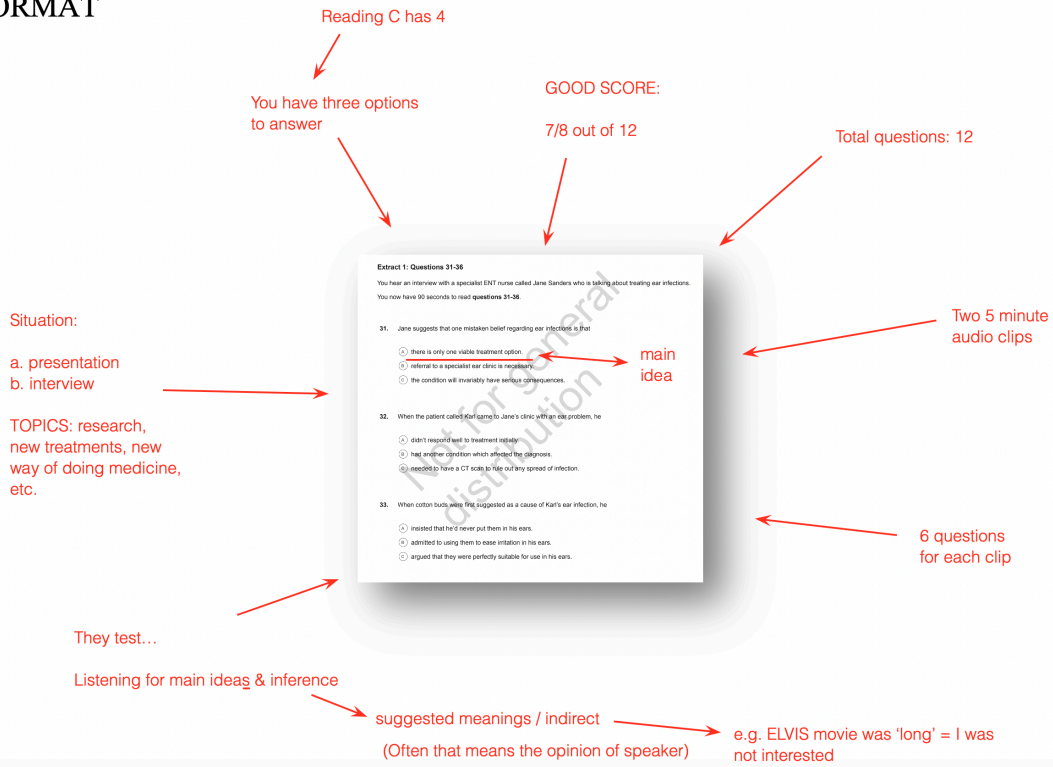


