- Identify the case notes you will use
- Organise the case notes into logical paragraphs

What is the situation after the above steps?

I can **focus on writing** = Perfect circumstances in which to write a letter

Identifying Purpose & Choosing Case Notes:

Ask yourself these questions about Adam Knowles case notes:

1. Who am I writing to?	gastroenterologist	
2. What do they already know?	 Do they know the patient? No Specialist knowledge about digestion / stomach & general medical knowledge 	
3. What do they need to know in order <u>to continue care</u> ?	 medical history social background investigation results current medications current symptoms 	
4. Why am I writing today?	We've received reports which indicate pancreatic cancer	
5. Is it urgent?	Yes	



Case Notes

Introductions

Common errors:

• Too much information in introduction – remember we 'expand on the purpose' later in the text = would affect your score in conciseness / organisation

Eg assessment is enough for the 'general request'

- Missing purpose don't say why they are writing
- Inaccurate purpose 'treatment' would be incorrect in this later
- Language errors punctuation, passive, tense, spelling, sentence structure.
