<p>How can I improve speaking?</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Improve your grammar • Improve your vocabulary <p>Practise: Find someone who is a good level but isn't judgemental – improve confidence</p> <p>Don't be so self-critical: Your writing brain and speaking brain are different – you can make more mistakes when speaking.</p> <p>Focus on learning:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Vocabulary: idiomatic, technical, descriptions, medical.... • Negatives, questions, tenses
<p>How can I improve my reading speed?</p> <p>How can I improve my listening?</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Improve your grammar • Improve your vocabulary • Practise your skills in real environments • Have a clear strategy – use the techniques that you learn in class
<p>How can I improve writing skills?</p>	<p>Have a planning approach – don't start writing until you are certain what structure & purpose your letter should have.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Purpose • Organisation • Content <p>The reader is the focus!</p>

<p>How should I study? Should I have a plan?</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Learn about the exam – modules / question types / content 2) Come to class/ watch class: combination – skills

Just use resources on offer to learn what you find difficult/easy4) Have a more targeted approach to your learning5) Submit writing to the marking team / Organise a live mock test6) Receive feedback on areas you need to work on7) Focus on these areas8) Study vocabulary & grammar every day
