TECHNIQUE

Signpost = tells us where we are and what is coming

A good signpost is a word NOT on the same line as a gap

- Heart attack subsequently diagnosed
- Reports some $\underline{\text{SYMPTOM}}$ \leftarrow at night They will paraphrase
