	<b>An apple was being eaten</b>	<b>An apple is being eaten</b>	<b>An apple will be being eaten</b>
<b>PERFECT</b>	I had eaten an apple	I have eaten an apple	I will have eaten an apple
	<b>An apple had been eaten</b>	<b>Apples have been eaten</b>	<b>An apple will have been eaten</b>

## What is Passive?

Start with Object of the sentence

I eat **apples**  
**Apples** were eaten  
 ○

Why use?

- Change focus
- Formal
- **It's about the PATIENT**

## What is the Passive with 2 Objects?

ACTIVE: John gave the **book** to **Mary**  
 S            v            O            O

Direct: receives action (points to book)  
 Indirect: benefits from action (points to Mary)

John gave Mary ~~to~~ the book

The **book** was given to Mary by John  
 O            be            V3            O            by            S

Mary was given the book by John  
 O            be            V3            O            by            B

**Note:** sometimes you cannot move one object to the start

Use: 'to' / 'for'

Alain put the book on Mary's head

1. The surgeon administered painkillers to Mr Jones

Mr Jones was administered painkillers

Painkillers were administered to Mr Jones

2. The nurse provided insulin injections **to** Mrs Green.

Injections were provided to Mrs Green

3. The dentist recommended fluoride toothpaste **to** Mrs Richards.

fluoride toothpaste was recommended to Mr Richards

4. The therapist *suggested* relaxation techniques **to** Mr Smith.

Mrs Smith was recommended relaxation techniques

5. The dermatologist recommended sunscreen lotion **to** Mrs White to prevent sunburn.

S v o u  
Mrs White was recommended sunscreen lotion to prevent sunburn

6. The psychiatrist prescribed antidepressants **to** Mr Johnston **to alleviate his symptoms.**

Mrs Johnson was prescribed antidepressants for the alleviation of his symptoms.

7. The physiotherapist recommended stretching exercises **to** Mrs Green **so she could reduce muscle soreness.**

Mrs Green was recommended stretching exercises so she...

8. The nutritionist suggested vitamin supplements **to boost Mr White's immune system.**

Vitamin supplements were recommended to Mr White to...

To = in the direct of

For = on behalf of / I am doing instead of them

FOR...

1. The nurse administered a flu shot **for** Mrs Richards

*A flu shot was administered for Mrs Richards*

*Mrs Richards was administered a flu shot*

2. The physiotherapist recommended exercises **for** Mr Smith's back pain.
3. The nutritionist prepared a customized meal plan for the Mr White's weight loss goals.
4. The therapist conducted cognitive behavioral therapy sessions **for** Mrs Green's anxiety disorder.
