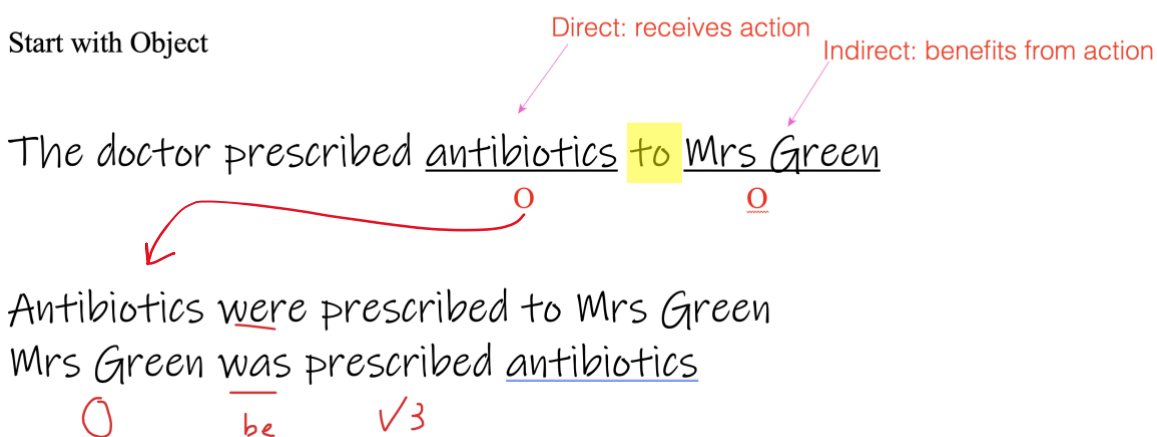

REVIEW

Passive:

Start with Object



It doesn't matter which Object you use but...

Sometimes we CANNOT use one of them because it doesn't make sense.

OET:

- Patient is doing it use ACTIVE
- Medical professionals doing it PASSIVE

EXAMPLE: The doctor prescribed painkillers **to** Mr. Johnson.

Mr Johnson was prescribed painkillers

Painkillers were prescribed....

1. Dr. Brown prescribed insulin **to** Mr. Robinson for his diabetes.
Insulin was prescribed to Mr Robinson for his diabetes
2. Dr. Smith recommended physical therapy **to** Mrs. Rodriguez for her knee injury.
Physical therapy was recommended to Mrs Rodriguez for her knee injury

3. Dr. White suggested **counseling** **to** Ms. Davis for her anxiety disorder.

Counseling was recommended to Ms Davis for...

Ms Davis was recommended **counselling** for...

4. The doctor prescribed antacids **to** Mr. Thompson for his gastric reflux.

Antacids were prescribed to Mr Thompson for....

Mr Thompson was prescribed antacids for....

5. The doctor **suggested/recommended** a gluten-free diet **to** Mr. Miller for his celiac disease.

A gluten free diet was suggested to Mr Miller for...

Mr Miller was suggested a gluten free diet for....

6. The doctor administered a flu shot to Joshua to protect him from seasonal influenza.

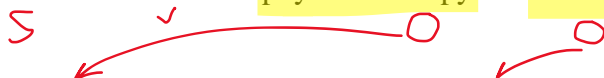
Joshua was administered a flu shot to....

2. The doctor ordered blood tests for Mr Smith to monitor his cholesterol levels.

Blood tests were ordered for Mr Smith to monitor...

Mr Smith was ordered blood tests... - **informal here but not incorrect**

3. The doctor recommended counselling for Mrs Jones to cope with the emotional challenges of chronic illness.

Counselling was recommended **for Mrs Jones** to cope...

Mrs Jones was recommended counselling to cope...

4. The doctor suggested relaxation techniques for Mrs Green to manage stress.

Relaxation were suggested for Mr Green to...

Mr Green was ~~suggested~~ recommended relaxation techniques

5. The doctor arranged a follow-up appointment for Mr Richards to monitor his progress.

Mr Richards was booked in a follow up appointment to monitor...

A follow up appointment was arranged for Mr Richards...

6. The doctor provided a referral for Mrs Green to a specialist regarding their neurological symptoms.

7. Doctor Johnson referred Mrs Green to a specialist for further evaluation
