What is a Participle Clause?

Connects 2 actions / situation

More than 1 type

Example: The car crashed, injuring 4 people.

Participle clause:	Relative clauses:
Connects 2 actions / state	Describes something
Example:	Example:
The car crashed, injuring 4 people.	I like pizza, which is delicious

How do we MAKE a participle cause?

The car crashed. Kinjured 4 people.

- 1. Remove Subject
- 2. Change verb to ING
- 3. Comma

<u> </u>	2. Opening the envelope, he read the referral letter 5 V2	Cooking dinner in the kitchen, Mr Green <u>listened</u> to the radio Listening to the radio, Mr Green <u>ate</u> dinner in the kitchen. Almost same time Opening the door, <u>she</u> saw a scary man
✓	3. Having opened the envelope, he read the referral letter ING V3	One after other (no time) Having finished the essay for the OET exam, he slept for many hours
×	4. A car crashed, injuring Mrs. Green's left shoulder	ING = result The tree fell down in the evening, breaking his left leg
✓	#. Being a doctor, she works a lot 5. Having a car, I drive a lot	Reason Being a nurse in a tertiary care hospital she <u>provides</u> care and support
