Why is spelling important?

In Listening Part A you need it

Small errors are allowed... Yes

How much! How many errors? What kind of errors?

- Do not change meaning (1. pear / 2. peer [colleague])
- SINGULAR / PLURAL: 's' will affect your grade (headache / headaches)
- UK / USA spellings not important
- Compound nouns not important
- Small vowel sound errors important
- Write down what you hear

Is it easy to spell a word if you do not **KNOW** it...?

What type of vocabulary causes the problems?

- Not medical terminology
- Describing pain and symptoms (informal)



Symptom Descriptions (gerund: adjectives*)

Spelling Test 1:

A – searing (very intense maybe hot pain)

B – gnawing (continuing pain – never goes away / keeps coming back / mice and rats: they gnaw on food)

C – tingling (like *pins and needles*)

D – throbbing thrubing (waves of pain)

E – fluttering (movement of wings)

Spelling Test 2

- This time: I will say a full sentence
- 10 not 5... there are some other ones
- Please note: I will paraphrase each sentence

I might change words or sequence

- 1 My leg is really **throbbing** it's like the blood is *flowing* in <u>waves</u>
- 2 I have this **stabbing** pain in my leg it's very intense *coming and going* (to stab with a knife)
- 3 My hand is **tingling** after I banged my elbow
- 4 There is a **shooting** pain all down my arm (to shoot a gun)
- 5 I just got this incredibly searing sensation after contact it was excruciating
- 6 There is this horrible **pulsing** / **pulsating** sensation like the blood is flowing in <u>waves</u>
- 7 It's a kind of **stinging** sensation very sharp not at all dull (like a bee bite)
- 8 I have this **gnawing** pain in my stomach its so awful and <u>relentless</u> <u>not stopping</u> (like a mouse or rat is eating you)
- 9 I have this incredible **piercing** pain in my chest it's like I am a kebab (stabbing / needle)
- 10 I had this **fluttering** sensation in my stomach like butterflies

Collocation:

Searing sensation = 2 words that native speakers use

Needling = 1. Stabbing 2. Constant bothering (gnawing)
