She is not in any pain from the cold just a few sniffles	Noun / verb	<i>I little bit informal:</i> 1. Flu: Sound from nose when people breath in to clear the nose passage To clear the mucus from runny nose Maybe from 'sniff'
We need to delve deeper into these issues because it is very unclear	Verb	1. Investigate 2. Go into
There is a blight on this population – we need a <i>cure</i>	Noun	Slight <i>old</i> word: 1. General illness : plague, disease, virus, etc.
I cannot discern any difference between them	Verb	1. Distinguish / Separate / Distinguish 2. Find / Recognise
She was gagging from the smell I am gagging to go to the concert	Gerund Gerund	1. Pre-vomit reflex (you don't always vomit) Informal: 2. Strongly want to / eager
He might take a knock <u>regardless</u> of which <i>sport</i>	Noun	1. <i>Injury</i> from contact 2. Small sporting injury
Without further ado , we should start	Phrase	1. We will do it now 2. Immediately Much Ado about Nothing = Shakespeare play Lots of action about nothing!
She is puffing and panting	Phrase	1. Quick breathing from exercise
