- no sexual intercourse for 2 months (use barrier contraception if takes place) & wait

3 months/2 menstrual cycles before pregnancy (arrange Dr urine test: hCG < 15 IU/L)

 future pregnancies high risk (but possible): need to monitor hCG levels, early ultrasound scans verify location of embryo

- folic acid supplements
