Sentence	Tense	Answer
"I'm selling all my books."	present continuous –	My brother said he was selling all his books.
	past continuous	
My brother said		My brother said he was going to sell his books.



"When are you leaving?"	present continuous –	My parents asked me when I was leaving.
My parents asked me	past continuous	when I was going to leave
		When we convert questions into reported speech, we convert them into statements
"I've booked the flights." Emma told me	present perfect – past perfect	Emma told me (that) she <u>had booked</u> the flights.
"I won't wear these shoes again." Jenny said	will - would	Jenny said that she would not wear those shoes again.
		near/now: this / these far/then: that / those
"How much money did you spend in the sales?" I asked my friend	past simple – past perfect	I asked my friend how much money he had spent.
"I didn't buy you a present." My girlfriend told me	past simple – past perfect	My girlfriend told me that she had not bought me a present.  My girlfriend said that she had not bought me a present.
"Can you help me?" Sally asked the policeman	present simple – past simple	Sally asked the policeman to help her ask + object + infinitive



		Sally asked the policeman if/whether he could help her.
"I can't find anywhere to park." Luke told me	present simple – past simple	Luke told me that he couldn't find anywhere to park.
"Where do you usually buy your clothes?" My sister asked me	present simple – past simple	My sister asked me where I usually bought my clothes.
"Will you be home early?" Anna asked Liam	will – would	Anna asked Liam if he would be home early.
